Essay must be typewritten.
 - ◆ Counselor must attach the applicant's academic transcript and test scores.
 - ◆ Copy of acceptance letter from the college, university, community college or trade school that you will be attending.
 - ◆ Current and accurate contact information.
 - ◆ Signatures where indicated on the application.
